All membership grades to receive Ground Engineering (except \*\*Retired – Life Member) and membership of either the International Society for Soil Mechanics and Geotechnical Engineering or the International Society for Rock Mechanics (except \*\*Retired – Life Member, Concessionary Student and Corporate). Membership of both societies is available to those receiving membership of a single society for an additional fee of £10.

\*\* Retired – Life Membership is free to members who are over the age of 65 and have been members of the BGA for at least five consecutive years. This membership does not include Ground Engineering or membership of either of the international societies. However, members will receive all information on meetings etc (as normally sent by email).

It should be noted that the ICE contributes to the running of the BGA by providing discounted costs for lecture space for the evening meetings and Annual BGA Conference, support personnel (including making arrangements for online broadcast lectures) and use of committee rooms.
